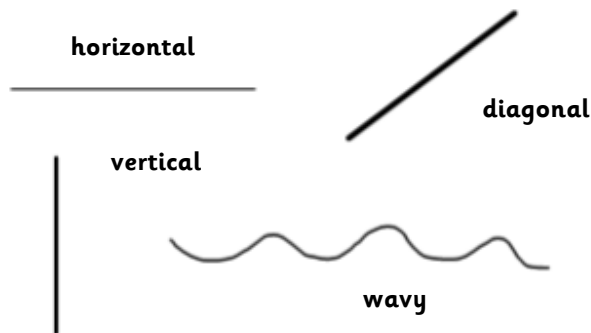


Year 1 – Art and Design Knowledge Organiser

Mark Making

Children will know how to hold a pencil correctly for drawing. They will explore mark making with a variety of mediums and materials. They will explore ways of drawing lines between two points. They will experiment with pressure when drawing pencil lines using a **HB** pencil and explore different kinds of pencils, observing the different marks they make.

Children will explore how **Kandinsky** used different lines in his artwork. They will know about the famous artist **Paul Klee**, imitating his techniques to create their own piece of art.



Super Sculptures

Children will know about the works of well-known sculptors. They will use a range of materials to create **sculptures** inspired by these famous sculptors.

Children will experiment with different **cutting tools** used to cut clay. They will know how to **roll** clay and use different tools to create **patterns**.

They will also create **kinetic sculptures** that **move** in the wind.

Colour Creations

Children will think about their favourite colours and the colours that are all around them every day. They will name the **primary colours**, **secondary colours** and will know how to mix secondary colours.

Children will know how to create **lighter shades** of colour using white and **darker shades** of colour using black.

They will use paint to create artwork in the style of a known artist.
