### Mathematics

### Nursery Children to know:

- Numbers are in an order
- Some position words and can point to a picture or object when asked
- Different position words and can use these to describe where an object or person is e.g. the present is under the tree
- Different words to use when talking about the weight of an object

### Reception Children to know:

- The numbers of the doors of the calendar and the Christmas Eve is the 24th December and Christmas Day is the 25th

### Nursery Children to know:

- Christmas is a festival celebrating the birth of Jesus
- Jesus was born in a stable

### Reception Children to know:

- That the Advent calendar us used to count the days to Christmas.
- Christmas is a festival celebrating the birth of Jesus, who Christians believe is the Son of God
- That Christmas eve is on the 24th December, Christmas Day is the 25th and the day after, the 26th is called Boxing day
- The different traditions that are carried out when celebrating Christmas i.e. decorating the home, putting up a tree, singing carols, exchanging cards and gifts, eating a special meal with family and friends
- That the Church is a special place, especially for Christians
- That special carols are sung at Christmas
- Some of the special features that are placed in the Church at Christmas - a nativity scene, garlands, wreaths, lights, candles
- The Nativity story and the key events that happened
