

This half term we will be covering a range of topics under the theme 'The Vikings'. We will be learning lots during class, but here are some ideas for you to get creative and complete at home. A **minimum of six pieces of homework are due by Monday 12th December**. You may spread these out over the half term, complete them all at once or bring them all in by the due date- the choice is yours!

<u>Get Writing</u> Find out about Viking Runes and create some of your own messages using them. 	<u>Design a Viking Meal</u> Design a Viking meal. It could be fun to have a go at making a recipe or two! Take pictures of you making it and annotate them to explain what you did. 	<u>Get Making</u> Create a model of a Viking longboat that can float. Or.... Make a model of a Viking long house. 
<u>Research</u> Research the Northern Lights and create your own piece of art. You could present your research as a poster or as a PowerPoint presentation. 	<u>Get Writing</u> Write a job advertisement for a Viking warrior. 	<u>Viking Money</u> Research what the Vikings used for money and create some of your own word problems to solve. 
<u>Get Writing</u> Write a fact file about a Viking god/goddess. Can you include your chosen god/goddess in your own Norse myth? 	<u>Get Writing</u> Write a diary entry for a Viking warrior. How would a diary entry be written long ago?	<u>Get Making</u> Design a Viking board game. How many players can play? What is the purpose of the game and how do you win?
