What month is the best to see northern lights

• You can see northern lights November to February . You see them 9pm to 2pm on a clear day and night . The best sighting is between 11pm to midnight . You may also see them in summer month's [June and Jully] they are sometime's out in day but we cant see them like stars.

•The aroura borealis [northern lights] is a vivid demonstration of the Earth's atmasfeer. They do not look verry high but are 80 to 120 km but can be higher
