PE

In History we will be looking at the Victorian era. We will learn about Queen Victoria, the Industrial revolution and how travel was made easier with steam trains and boats. We will find out about new inventions, the Commonwealth and how schools changed with the education act.

In **D&T** we will be designing and making a book sleeve. We will be developing our sewing skills and personalising by decorating it.

In **Science** we will be looking at changes of state. We will be grouping materials into solids, liquids and gases and finding out how they change. We will be finding out about where we see evaporation and condensation in our daily life, as well as learning about the water cycle.

In **Music** our theme is Mamma Mia. We will learn to sing it and listen to Abba songs.

In **Computing**, we will be studying computer networks and systems as well as using the internet safely and correctly. We will also look at audio editing.

In Literacy, we will use a book based approach using texts to support our writing. We will be writing explanations of the life cycle of a plant. We will be practicing our story writing by writing legends, mystery stories and sequels.

In **Maths** we will be concentrating on place value, addition and subtraction. We will be practicing our 2,3,4,5,8 and 10 times tables.

In French, we will be learning numbers to 20, days of the week and months of the year. We will be learning the names of places in school and different classroom objects.

In Geography we will be locating Europe on a world map and naming at least 8 capital cities within Europe. We will also be locating capital cities across the world.

In **RE** we will be learning more about the bible and stories from the Old and New Testament.

In Art we will be looking at the artists William Morris. We will be developing our sketching skills focusing on shading as well as printing with at least 3 different colours.
