In **English**, we will use a book based approach using texts to support our writing. We will look at a non-fiction picture book, romantic comedy, science fiction and fantasy fiction.

Through these texts, we will write our own expanded explanations, play scripts, science fiction narratives and mythical narratives.

In History, we will learn all about 'The Vikings'. We will find out where the Vikings originated from, know why they came to the UK, and how they travelled. We will find out about Viking life and homes by studying the settlement of JORVIK.

In **Maths**, we will cover place value, addition and subtraction, statistics, multiplication and division followed by perimeter and area.

In Music, we will learn to play the drums with Mr Townsend and we will begin by studying Military drumming.

Our topics during the Autumn Term are:

South America and The Vikings In **Computing**, we will look at E-safety. This will cover spam emails, creating strong passwords and staying safe online.

In D&T, we will look at seasonal foods and link this to our Viking topic, by making our own Viking stew.

In Art, we will create some Viking art and explore marks and lines to create different textures. We will use different shades of sketching pencils to draw Viking patterns and even create a piece of Viking jewellery.

In R.E, we will learn about Christianity through some less familiar bible stories. After recapping stories they will already know (Noah's Ark or the Christmas story) we will explore different aspects of the Christian faith by meeting characters including Ruth, Daniel, John the Baptist and

In **Geography**, we will look at some of the countries that make up South America. We will study their climate, human geography and trade.

In **Science**, we will learn about Earth and Space by studying the planets, the movement of the moon and night and day. We will also look at Forces in Action including gravity and air resistance.
