






Homework Grid Spring Term 2

Could you find out more about what it was like being a poor and being a rich Tudor and write a paragraph comparing the two?</p> | <p><u>Doctor, Doctor</u></p> <p>Can you find out about different diseases and illnesses that were around in the Tudor times. How did doctors try to cure their patients?</p> | <p><u>Dinner Time</u></p> <p> Tudor Kings and Queens held massive banquets. Find out what might happen at one and prepare a menu.</p> |
| <p><u>Home Sweet Home</u></p> <p> Find out about Tudor houses. How were they built? What did they look like? Draw a diagram or make a model.</p> | <p><u>Who was William Shakespeare?</u></p> <p>Can you find out who he was and why he is famous? Could you write a fact file about him?</p> <p></p> | <p><u>A Family Crest</u></p> <p>Rich Tudor families had their own crests which were put on shields. Can you design and make your own?</p> <p></p> |
| <p><u>Dressing up</u></p> <p> Find out more about rich Victorian clothes. What did they wear? Draw a diagram to explain how dress was different from today?</p> | <p><u>All in a Day's Work</u></p> <p>Find out what different jobs Tudors did. Choose one, think about what qualities you would need and write an advert for the job.
