Task 1- Find out who Oliver Twist was and what his famous saying was. Watch some of the videos on you tube or the whole film.

Task 2 - Make and try some gruel. Write a review. Would you like to have to eat it every day?

Victorian Buildings

Find out about a Victorian building, such as the Royal Albert Hall. Draw a picture or sketch of it and explain what it is used for today.

Task 1 - Find out about what a Victorian Christmas was like

Task 2 - make your own Victorian Christmas decoration from Salt dough or pine cones.

Compare coins from the Victorian era to today. How is it different? Can you find how much simple things were in the Victorian times such as milk, bread, meat, clothes, etc.
