How has your school's spending improved PE attainment?	Allowing the children to have better equipment and access to the competitions has greatly improved our attainment in PE leading us to have a higher standard in the competitions leading to us winning the overall most competitions by being consistently better than we have been in certain sports. This is due to better knowledge of staff in lessons and leader through support from the Grassroots CPD. It has also allowed assistants to be better trained and understand the context of each event before they attend. We have also had a lot higher take up in after school clubs due to the experiences at competitions and in the standard of lessons.
How has your school's spending increased pupil PE and sport activity levels?	It has allowed 95% of children in ks1 and 2 to go to at least one competition and the other children being offered the chance to go by having a range of opportunities even if they declined the chance. It has also seen a higher engagement in the lessons.

How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?	The spending has given us the opportunity to attend the competitions at a high class venue and other schools in the area. It has given us the chance to work with specialist staff which has lead to more children attending out of school clubs.
How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?	Having the competitions and build up in lessons has allowed the children to engage in differing sports and then they have either joined after school clubs at school or in the local area. We have seen an increase in take up of the usually less well attended sports
How has your school's spending increased staff training and continued professional development (CPD)?	it has allowed us to get in a PE lead who has supported with CPD giving staff a higher confidence to deliver high quality lessons. All teaching staff and assistants have attended sessions which has impacted on lesson standards and competition standards as well as a better knowledge for the PE lead.
How has your school's spending increased staff participation in extra-curricular activities and school sports competitions?	Staff are more willing to go to competitions and do after school sessions as they are more confident in delivering after the CPD sessions and the online lesson plans.
How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?	Catch up swimming has allowed more of our children to achieve 25 metres - 15 more children achieved in year 6 did than in year 4. (This class missed a lot of original lessons due to Covid 19.) 25 out of 28 managed 25 metres.
How has your school's spending improved water safety awareness?	Allowed us to bring in a company to deliver water safety as well as a further session from the people who lead our swimming sessions coming into school to do a talk on water safety.
