
READING RECORDS

In **History** we will be looking at Queen Elizabeth I and her reign during the Tudor times. We will learn about the social structure of these times and find out more about famous some explorers - Sir Welter Raleigh and Sir Francis Drake.

In computing we will be formatting images, using spellcheck, inserting and formatting tables and using hyperlinks. We will also be recording and editing video using iMovie.

In **Science** we will be learning about Electricity. We will be learning about to construct circuits and the different components. We will be learning to recognise common conductors and insulators. We will also be carrying out lots of investigations. We will also be learning about sounds thinking about how sounds are made, how sounds travel and how we hear sounds.

In **Music** we will be performing the song Stop!. This is a rap about bullying and we will have a go writing our own.

In **D&T** we will be designing and making our own working torches using our knowledge from our science topic 'electricity'.

In Literacy, we will use a book based approach using texts to support our writing. Using a range of fiction and non fiction texts such as Cinnamon, Odd and the Frost Giants, Winter's Child and The Matchbox Diary.

In Maths In Maths our areas of learning and multiplication and division, fractions and decimals.

In French, children will be learning about the Epiphany in France. They will also learn to name family members and how to describe people using correct

word order.

In Geography we will be using maps and aerial photos to locate and describe some British and world mountains. We will look at how mountains are formed and look in detail at a mountain range.

In **RE** we will be learning about some of the core beliefs in the Buddhist religion.

In Art we will be focusing on sketching and painting plant art and will be looking at the work of Georgia O'Keeffe. We will also be using clay to produce a sculpture.
