In Year 3 we will be learning lots of new and interesting facts during the Spring Term.

In **History** we will be learning that mining was the main way of life in Barnsley and that there was a major disaster in a Barnsley pit – The Oaks Disaster - in 1866, which changed mining in the future.

In **Art** we will be finding out about architects and studying famous buildings including the work of Sir Christopher Wren and his design for St Paul's Cathedral in London.

In **Music** we will be following the 'Charanga' scheme and will learn about Reggae music. We will learn 'Three Little Birds' by Bob Marley and The Wailers.

In **PD** we will be learning about how to develop and maintain healthy relationships.

In **RE** we will be learning about why Easter is important for Christians.

We will also look at beliefs surrounding life after death.

In **DT** we working with textiles to design, make and evaluate a cushion. We will be using different stitches and applique to decorate.



In **Computing** we will be learning about word processing and desktop publishing. We will develop skills so that we can create a poster that includes text and images.

In **PE** we will be learning to play basketball, dance, tag rugby and swimming.
