# <u>P.E.</u>

For the Summer term year 1 P.E. will be every Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure that P.E. kits are in school that day and any jewellery, (including earrings) is removed.

### **READING RECORDS**

Children will read every day in their Read, Write Inc. lessons. All children will bring home a Read, Write, Inc phonics book every day and a new 'Book Bag' book every Friday. Please ensure these are brought to school each day. Your child will also receive a book of their choice from the school library, which needs to be returned each Friday so they can change it for another one. Please record in your child's reading record each time they read at home. If children read at home once per day they will receive a prize at the end of the week.

# **HOMEWORK**

Children will be given weekly spellings to practise at home. These will be a mixture of the year 1 common exception words and words containing Year 1 spelling rules. In addition to this, children will also be given a sheet containing the sound that we are working on in phonics, along with words to practise. There may also be occasions when your child will receive homework to support a specific learning task in literacy, maths or the wider curriculum.

## **PHONICS**

Children will complete the phonics screening test in June and over the coming weeks they will receive resources to help them to prepare for this at home. We will continue daily phonics lessons to practise and re-cap sounds we have learned.
