
#### READING RECORDS

In History we will continue with our topic the Tudors. Children will find out when and how Henry became king and what he was like as a king. We will also find out why he had 6 wives and how this shaped history.

In computing we will be recording and editing video using iMovie. We Will also be improving our coding skills by programming simple games and learning what variables, looping and debugging is.

In **Science**, we will be learning about living things. We will start of learning about humans and the digestion process. We will be to explain this process and name all the main parts that help with this. We will also be looking at teeth and will do an experiment to find out how drinks affect our teeth. We will then move on to classifying different living things.

In **Music** we will be listening to music by the Beatles and will be learning to sing the song Blackbird.

In **D&T** we will be tasting and making biscuits. We will evaluate different biscuits and will adapt a biscuit recipe to make it healthier.

In Literacy, we will use a book based approach using texts to support our writing. Using a range of fiction and non-fiction texts such as The Story of Tutankhamun and The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe.

In RE we will be recapping what we learn about Buddhism and learning more about Buddhist festivals and the scared texts.

In **Maths** our areas of learning are decimals, money, statistics, shapes, position and direction.

In French, through songs, games and independent tasks, children will:

- -use singular nouns for jungle animals and using adjectives to describe them
- -follow and understand a simple story, -
- -write simple sentences in French.

In Geography we will learn about rivers in the UK and other important rivers around the world. We will be able to locate these of a map and will know the key features of a river, as well as recap the water cycle.
