### Verb Bank

All the words below are part of verbs:

**Regardez!** - look

**Ecoutez!** - listen

**Répétez!** - repeat

**Levez-vous!** - stand up

**Asseyez-vous!** - sit down

**Comptez avec moi!** - count with me

**Chantez avec moi!** – sing with me

**Trouvez moi!** - find me

**Montrez moi!** - show me

### Noun Bank

**Le café**- the cafe

**Le cinéma**- the cinema

**Le restaurant** – the restaurant

**Le supermarché**- the supermarket

**Le stade** – the stadium

**La boulangerie**- the bakers

**La pharmacie**- the chemist

**L'école** – the school

### Facts

In English we have borrowed some French nouns for places in town e.g. **café**, **cinema**, **restaurant**...

### Grammar

When a noun begins with a vowel and it is being used with “**le**” or “**la**”, then the vowel at the end of “**le**” or “**la**” is replaced with an apostrophe  
e.g. **l' école**
