Medium Term Plan: Stage 2 My town, your town

In this module:

During this half term children will revisit colours and write a poem about fireworks. The children will revisit classroom commands to programme their own robots! Next, they'll learn shop names in town, explore shopping in France, and practise asking for shop locations in robot-style voices!

Through songs, games, native speaker clips and independent tasks, they will explore the following content, topics and language:

Fireworks

- Revisit and recall colours
- Write a poem about fireworks using colours

Classroom commands

- Practise classroom instructions
- Practise writing useful commands

Places in town

- Explore what shopping is like in France, and similarities and differences between here and in France
- Practise asking where something is
- Respond with the structure 'Here is...'
- Recognise the names of places in a town written down

Learning Objective for each lesson:

- 1) I can write my own "Fireworks" poem
- 2) I can say and understand classroom commands.
- 3) I can use classroom commands to programme a robot.
- 4) I can say and write some places in town.
- 5) I can ask "Where is...?" and answer with "Here is..."
- 6) I can understand more nouns for shops in French.
