Medium Term Plan: Stage 3 Time in the city

In this module:

During this half term, the children will review and build on what they've learned about places from Stage 2. They'll learn about Paris, explore its facts, and practice language for buying tickets and asking for directions. They'll also become tour guides, writing rainbow sentences. For a Christmas-themed activity, they'll design festive jumpers. Through games, native speaker clips and independent tasks, they will explore the following content, topics and language:

In the city

- Explore a city in France including reading and understanding facts
- Look at nouns for places in a town or city, including shops
- Explore language for buying tickets to a tourist attraction, including the polite request
- Describe a city in the role of a tour guide

Souvenir shopping

- Learn and remember nouns for souvenirs
- Recognise and understand prices
- Ask for a price

Festive jumpers

- Design and describe a Christmas jumper

Learning Objective for each lesson:

- I can understand some facts about the capital city of France.
- I can ask for an entrance ticket.
- 3) I can give and understand some simple directions around the city.
- I can say and write a description of the city.
- 5) I can buy a souvenir and ask for a price.
- 6) I can describe a festive jumper.
