In this module:

This half term the children will be learning nouns for funfair rides, adjectives to describe the rides and how to express personal opinions about rides and funfairs. Children will be introduced to the 'o'clock' and 'half past' structure in French, and some daily routine phrases to be able to write a sequence of daily routine phrases including times to describe a day out at the funfair or theme park. Through songs, games and independent tasks, they will explore the following content, topics and language:

Funfair rides

- Learn the nouns for rides in French
- Learn descriptions of rides and apply these appropriately
- Express opinions of rides and funfairs

Daily routine

- Learn some daily routine phrases

Telling the time

- Learn the structure for telling time in French, focusing on "o'clock" and "half past

My best day ever

- Understand a description of a day out at the funfair
- Plan and describe a funfair visit using time and routine phrases
