**Year 6 Visit - Experience Barnsley Museum & Retrodome Visit
Tuesday 16th June 2026**

To support our learning and as part of our Year 6 children's last half term at Ladywood, we have arranged a visit to the Experience Barnsley Museum to take part in a workshop about Egyptian history. The workshop runs in the morning and we would then like to take the children to the Retrodome for some fun and games in the afternoon.

To minimise the cost, we will travel by public bus leaving school after registration, we will aim to be back in time for a normal finish at 3.15pm but this will be subject to buses/traffic and we will update you if there is a change.

The cost of this day will be £10 per pupil, this covers the museum workshop and Retrodome entry fees. This cost has been subsidised by school, however, we do not have the funds available to fund this visit completely and do rely on parental contributions.

If your child has a MI Card, bus travel will be free of charge and we have not included this in the cost. If your child doesn't have a MI Card yet, it's simple and free to apply. Go to <https://www.travelsouthyorkshire.com/en-gb/ticketsandpasses/barnsley-micard#apply>. Cards are valid until the end of the school year in 2027 so the children will then have them ready for moving up to secondary school too.

All children will need a packed lunch and plenty to drink (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please). If you would like, we can provide your child with a packed lunch from school, if you pay for school meals the normal meal cost will apply - **please let us know by Friday 21st May if you require this.**

All children must wear full school uniform for the visit with suitable shoes, coat etc. depending upon the weather.

In order for your child to take part in this visit, please i) apply for a MI Card if your child doesn't already have one and ii) make your contribution via the Arbor app. As part of the payment process you will be asked to provide your consent. By providing consent you:

- *agree to your child taking part in the above activity and his/her participation in the activities described*
- *acknowledge the need for obedience and responsible behaviour on his/her part and are aware of the procedure for returning pupils home prior to the end of the visit where their behaviour endangers the Health and Safety of other pupils.*

- *agree to your son/daughter receiving emergency medical surgical and dental treatment, including anaesthetic, and blood transfusions that may be considered necessary by the medical authorities present. - *understand the school's policy on the administration of medicines.*
- *understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided.*
- *undertake to inform the school as soon as possible of any change in the medical circumstances between the date of signing and the commencement of the journey.*
- *understand that the details disclosed could be passed on to the organiser's insurer and/or medical adviser if necessary.*
