**Year 2 Visit - Yorkshire Sculpture Park  
Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

We have booked a visit to take the children to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park to complement our Art topic on sculptures. During the day, the children will visit the galleries and have plenty of time to explore the park and sketch some of the amazing sculptures we see, we'll go on a nature hunt and see some of the other exhibitions there too, as well as the play spaces!

We will travel by coach leaving school at 9.15am and arriving back in time for a normal finish at 3.15pm.

The cost of this visit covers the cost of coach travel and park/gallery entrance fees and has been subsidised by school. The school does not have the funds available to fund this visit completely and therefore rely on parental contributions, in the unlikely event that we do not receive a contribution from each child, we may be forced to cancel this trip.

All children will need a packed lunch and plenty to drink (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please). As all children in Year 2 are eligible for Universal Free School Meals, if you would like, we can provide your child with a packed lunch from school - **please let us know by Friday 15<sup>th</sup> May if you require this.**

All children must wear full school uniform for the visit with suitable shoes, coat etc. depending upon the weather.

In order for your child to take part in this visit, please make your contribution via the Arbor app. As part of the payment process you will be asked to provide your consent. By providing consent you:

- *agree to your child taking part in the above activity and his/her participation in the activities described*
- *acknowledge the need for obedience and responsible behaviour on his/her part and are aware of the procedure for returning pupils home prior to the end of the visit where their behaviour endangers the Health and Safety of other pupils.*
- *agree to your son/daughter receiving emergency medical surgical and dental treatment, including anaesthetic, and blood transfusions that may be considered necessary by the medical authorities present. NOTE: If there are any exceptions to your child receiving medical treatment please supply an accompanying letter stating what those exceptions are.*
- *understand the school's policy on the administration of medicines.*
- *understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided.*
- *undertake to inform the school as soon as possible of any change in the medical circumstances between the date of signing and the commencement of the journey.*
