Dear Parent/Carer,

**Year 4 Visit - Ewden Water Treatment Centre
Tuesday 30th June 2026**

We have booked a visit to take the children to the Ewden Water Treatment Centre to complement our science topic on the water cycle. During the day, the children will visit different parts of the site and take part in a series of different workshops and fun activities to learn more about the water cycle, where our water comes from and how waste water is treated.

We will travel by coach leaving school at 9am, we will return at 2.45pm and so should arrive back at school for around 3.30pm

The cost of this visit covers coach travel and transfers during the day and has been subsidised by school. The school does not have the funds available to fund this visit completely and therefore we rely on parental contributions, in the unlikely event that we do not receive a contribution from each child, we may be forced to cancel this trip.

All children will need a packed lunch and plenty to drink (no glass bottles or fizzy pop please). Alternatively, a school packed lunch may be ordered (if you do not normally pay for your school meals, no charge will apply). If you would like to order a school packed lunch **please let us know by Friday 5th June if you require this.**

All children must wear full school uniform for the visit. For health and safety reasons this includes suitable closed toe shoes, long sleeved tops and full length trousers/leggings/tights.

In order for your child to take part in this visit, please make your contribution via the Arbor app. As part of the payment process you will be asked to provide your consent. By providing consent you:

- *agree to your child taking part in the above activity and his/her participation in the activities described*
- *acknowledge the need for obedience and responsible behaviour on his/her part and are aware of the procedure for returning pupils home prior to the end of the visit where their behaviour endangers the Health and Safety of other pupils.*
- *agree to your son/daughter receiving emergency medical surgical and dental treatment, including anaesthetic, and blood transfusions that may be considered necessary by the medical authorities present. NOTE: If there are any exceptions to your child receiving medical treatment please supply an accompanying letter stating what those exceptions are.*
- *understand the school's policy on the administration of medicines.*
- *understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided.*
